Custom RoIP Hardware from PHASE 4 DESIGN gives state agency radio coverage across Central Washington and the San Juan Islands.

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May 16, 2014 – Kenmore, WA – Dave Grant, President of Phase 4 Design, Inc. announces completion of a project to add RoIP radio coverage across Central Washington and the San Juan Islands.

Beginning in January of 2013, Phase 4 Design started a project to expand the existing RoIP Radio Dispatch Coverage for the Washington State Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW).

The project would entail designing, building and installing 5 new RoIP Remote Base Stations. The new base stations would add new coverage in Northwest Washington as well as most of the Central part of the State. The new station would need to harden for protection against lightning and have the ability for extended runtime on internal battery.

Grant commented, "We designed a completely self-contained remote RoIP base. Great emphasis was placed on surge protection. RF, AC Line, even the Ethernet connection is protected."

With the installation of the RoIP base in Omak, WDFW Dispatch [WILDCOMM] will have access to 12 new wide area radio repeaters.
